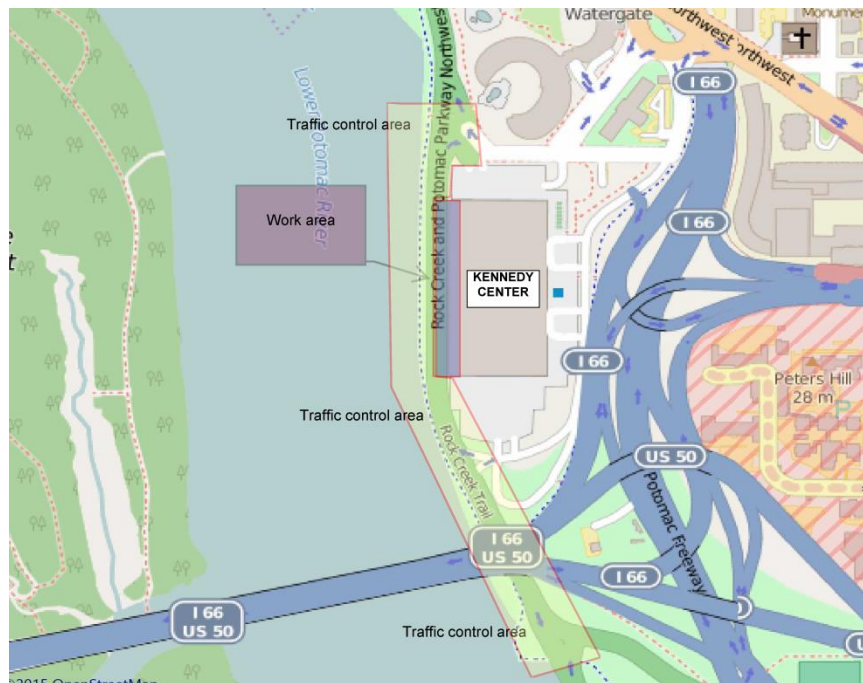
### **Kennedy Center Schedules Overnight Repairs To Rock Creek Parkway Overhang June 6 through September 29**

*Drivers should make note of altered traffic patterns*

(WASHINGTON)—The Kennedy Center has announced it will conduct necessary repairs to the concrete overhang structure positioned above Rock Creek Parkway from **June 6 through September 29, 2016**, which will impact traffic patterns during the overnight hours. The affected work area is along Rock Creek Parkway between F Street and the Roosevelt Bridge. The scheduled repair work will occur **Monday through Thursday nights from 10 p.m. until 6 a.m.**

Between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m., one lane will remain open for travel in alternating directions controlled by flagmen. Drivers may expect delays. Vehicle traffic in the southbound lanes is encouraged to exit to an alternate route at Virginia Avenue. Patrons' arrival to and departure from the Kennedy Center will not be impacted. Standard rush hour traffic patterns will remain unchanged.
